The yard sale fundraiser for the Honduras and Samara mission projects is Saturday, March 6. You may bring your donations and leave them in the foyer (in boxes, please).

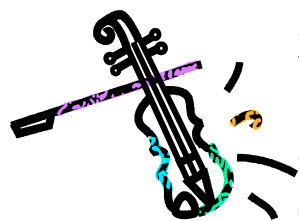
